Recent Developments and Outlook

- NTP Mo-99 manufacture on one line (40% capacity) since late May.
 - Await regulator approval to resume 2nd Mo-99 production line
 - I-131 production has resumed and is expected to return to normal in Sept.
- ANSTO/ANM limited production since mid-July
 - Late June contamination incident led to regulatory restriction of 2 runs/week, for Australian domestic market
 - 1 month OPAL scheduled Sept 2019 maintenance postponed to June 2020
- NMEu communications (22 July and 8 August) re: Mo-99 & I-131 supply situation through mid-October
 - Likely intermittent Mo-99 and I-131 supply shortages
 - Medical institutions should contact their Tc-99m generator/I-131 supplier or radiopharmacies to be informed of weekly supply situation
- IRE has deferred its planned early November maintenance outage until TBD 2020.
- New NMEu communication next week.

 - 2020 Rev. 1 by mid-September
